

A bride's bouquet is her most important accessory, appearing in many of the wedding photographs. It should complement her dress and the general style of the wedding, and there is a huge array of wonderful wedding flowers to choose from. Beautiful bridal bouquets can take the form of small posies or large shower bouquets, they can be formal or informal and they can incorporate your favourite flowers, chosen to match your colour scheme.

If you're looking for something different to make a real impact, why not consider an eye-catching shower bouquet? (as seen on page 37). These bouquets are skilfully wired to cascade gently downwards. They are suited to exotic flowers like lilies and orchids, as well as contemporary designs. These flowing bouquets will radiate opulence, glamour and romance on your unforgettable day.

Hand-tied bouquets can be anything from formal posies to rustic bunches of seasonal flowers. A tightly formed hand-tied posy is the perfect choice for a bride who likes fuss free, clean lines, as seen on page 42. Other brides may prefer a looser, more organic arrangement of flowers and foliage.

Another popular style of bouquet is the teardrop bouquet, as seen on page 11. This is a lovely balance between the shower bouquet and the hand-tied. It can be either small and elegant or large and loose — and will make a big impression without the formality of the shower bouquet.

When choosing your bridesmaids' bouquets, we often suggest using the same or coordinating flowers as the bride but in a smaller arrangement, generally in a posy style. Younger bridesmaids and flower girls may prefer to wear a floral headband or carry a pomander, basket or flower wand, as seen on page 36.

When choosing a groom's buttonhole, you can couple it by using an accent flower from the bridal bouquet (such as a rose), with a few flourishes to make it stand out. Ushers and the best man may want a simpler version of the groom's buttonhole, or to choose something slightly different such as a flower to tie in with the bridesmaid's bouquets.


Corsages can be worn by female members of the wedding party including the mother of the bride. They can be worn on the wrist, as seen on page 41, or used to adorn a bag.



We are available for wedding appointments seven days a week, and we will have as many consultations with you as necessary. To book an appointment with one of our wedding florists, simply contact your local Longacres store. Flowers bring joy, and we aim to make the ordering process as easy and pleasurable as possible! Our experienced florists will be on hand to provide appropriate guidance and assistance throughout.

During your consultation you will meet with a wedding florist in our private wedding studio, to discuss all your requirements in a calm and quiet atmosphere. We do not charge for our consultations, but we do charge for any mock up designs you wish to have made.

Once you have had your first consultation we will be able to send you a quote, outlining all the requirements discussed. Don't worry if you haven't nailed down all the details at this point; it is just a base to start from and we can amend or add elements as we move closer to your big day. All we need at this point is a small deposit to secure your date, with the balance being required at least a month prior to your wedding.

The team are on hand right through until your wedding day to answer any questions or queries and to help take away any last-minute panic, stress or worry. We have a substantial floristry workroom and a large team of skilled florists!

On your requested day (usually the day of your wedding) we will deliver your flowers to you. We can organise as many deliveries as you require, for example to the bridal party and the groom and groomsmen, as well as the ceremony and/or reception venue. If you would prefer to collect your flowers this can be discussed and arranged during your wedding consultation.
